Mission Spotlight:

Chase Corner Ministries is located at 1604 Chase High Road in Forest City and assists families in the Chase community and across Rutherford County.

In addition to providing free food, the center provides financial crisis assistance to eligible clients, operates a thrift store, and provides clothing.

The center was established in 1979 to meet the needs of the community.

There is always a need for volunteers, gently used items for the thrift store, and monetary donations.

Cynthia Cooper, executive director says, "Many families in this community, either from lack of adequate salary/work or disability or crisis, depend on Chase Corner Ministries to sustain their food resources. We are fortunate our partnership with Second Harvest Food Bank and the community giving has provided enough food for us to operate three pantry options: USDA distribution each Wednesday, Mobile Food Trucks one each month providing large surges of food into a food insecure household, and Emergency Pantry open the other four days of the week for those to walk in who need immediate food."

Funding and donations of food keep the pantry operational to meet critical needs for families.

The Center has become a strong referral and resource to clients to meet greater crisis needs thanks to the strong partnerships across the county, including Florence Baptist Church. Available funding assists with rent, utilities, and prescriptions

Florence Baptist is providing \$2,400 from the annual local missions budget to Chase Corner Ministries this year.

"We are so grateful and never take for granted that without this community support we could not make the impact we do to all of Rutherford county residents as we have clients from across this vast county," Cooper said.

Matthew 24:3-8,29-32,42-44


When have you found yourself counting down to a big event? There are some big milestones in our lives that we look forward too: Graduation, Marriage, Birth of a child, Retirement. But the biggest event of all time awaits humanity: Christ's return! Life as we know it changes with the milestones we experience through life and especially when we see Jesus.
